 agencies within the state of California.
- Assisting CIFT in marketing and ministry efforts, including helping to generate your own referrals.

Education Required:

 Masters degree in Marriage and Family Therapy, Social Work, Clinical Psychology, or related field and/or Doctoral degree in Clinical Psychology, Marriage and Family Therapy, Social Work, or related field.

Requirements:

- Must be a Licensed Psychotherapist within the State of California (license must be active, in good standing).
- Must pass a background check.

Previous Experience:

- Prior clinical experience providing psychotherapeutic services required.
- Understanding of and experience/practice within a psychodynamically oriented treatment approach is preferred.
